





Hope to see everyone there.



General Membership Meeting – On September 3, the meeting was opened at approximately 7 PM, with over 30 members and guests in attendance. VP David led Introductions with what Z car you drive and your favorite Z car color. This was followed by our speaker, Jason Dumas. Jason is from the San Diego chapter of the Pontiac Oakland Club International and talked about the Cops and Rodders show at the Embarcadero Marina Park North on September 28th. Over 90% of the proceeds (after expenses) go to three charities: Fisher House, Police Historical Society, and Fleet Week.

Past Events: Idyllwild Cruz, led by Dennis Darnall, had 11 cars (8 were Zs) and 22 people. Everyone had a great time, and there was a lot of shopping going on... hats anyone? And, Z Across America, a ZCCA event held before the National Convention. Greg and Clif told us about their experience joining the Southern California leg.

Future Events: South Orange County Cars and Coffee on September 13th led by VP David. North County Deer Park Winery drive on September 20th, again led by Dennis.
