


# Your Board in Action



### I. Most important things we learned at ZCON13:

(1) SPONSORS ARE THE KEY! Make personal contact with all sponsors and keep doing so regularly. Stay in touch with all the sponsors regularly until the event. Do not just consider automobile-related businesses as sponsors. Any people-related company is a potential sponsor for ZCON14. (i.e. – Ask Costco to donate a pallet of bottled water to use with volunteers and attendees at the car show.)

#### (2) KEY ELEMENTS FOR SUCCESS:

- a) Get organized and stay on track.
- b) Recruit the right people for the right tasks.
