


Don't let the thought of the heat keep you away! It's amazingly cool during the movie!

- 5. Rally check point locations will NOT be given out until the day of the event (so don't bother asking).
- 6. Rally starting point will be in San Diego and exact location to be given out 5 days before the start.

- 8. This is not a speed contest, getting caught violating the law will get you automatically disqualified.

Please note only the judge at the finish can officially verify your Location Proof as being correct.

Do not delete your Location Proof until after the finish and told to do so.

The route and order you follow is solely up to you.

The winner will be determined by total points.

The driver with the most points wins.

THE RUN TO BIG BEAR CONRINUED





Has balanced Chevy 400 cubic inch 4 bolt main engine. Approximately 425 HP and 425 Ft Lbs torque. Borg Warner T-56 6-speed double overdrive transmission (will handle 450 Ft Lbs of torque). Full roll cage which ties in to struts (the body does not flex). Adjustable suspension (both height and camber) with Tokiko adjustable shocks. Many spare parts. 2100 miles since built. I have the paperwork and receipts. Interior plastic panels are not installed, but are good. The car is not pretty (the body is not

done), but it is fast. The car was built 1995-1996 and was the fastest car in the time trials at the 9th annual Z Car Convention in 1996 held in Denver. It has been garaged and started and run two or three times a year since then. Everything in the engine, clutch, and transmission was new at

that time. Since I haven't done much with it for 7 years I think it is time

to sell it if I can get a decent price for it. I'm getting older now and prefer sitting is a soft seat with air conditioning rather than lying on a concrete floor and getting skinned knuckles. The body has had floor panels welded in. There was rust, as usual around the wheel wells which has been cut out with the idea of putting on the fiberglass fender flares. Also some rust in front of the drivers door in the rocker panel area. The car is legal to drive and passed Colorado emissions as it is when I had it licensed

in Denver 7 years ago. There are no emission requirements here in Grand Junction. The engine has forged crank, connecting rods, pistons. Hydraulic 7000 rpm camshaft and lifters. Trick Flow Twisted wedge heads. Engine is balanced. Holley 650 cfm double pumper carb. MSD ignition. Road race oil pan. Electronic tach and calibrated speedometer. Hooker headers. Centerforce clutch. 3" exhaust. Air dam with air ducted to front brakes. 280Z rear end.

Spare parts: hood, one front fender, grill, 280Z rear end, full? Set of instruments and switches, window risers, new stock shocks, Longacre castor, camber gage, bigger cam and lifters (wouldn't pass emissions), Four fiberglass fender flares, half shafts, heater motor, 4 custom built rims with P245/50 ZR15 tires, inside and outside rear fender repair panels 1 each, rear bumper. No parts will be sold separately.


