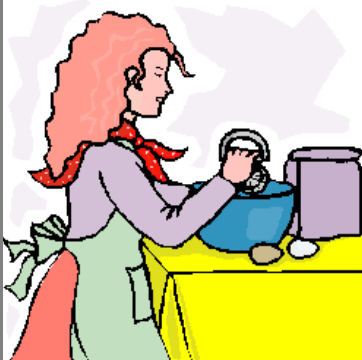
Meeting directions:
