



Our friend **Clif Yaussi** is ZCSD second former president from 1994 to 1996. Under his presidency some of the activities that took place were: visit to the Peterson Museum, Palomar Observatory, Z Across America, Bondurant Driving School, March Air force Base, Fast Food Rally, Nissan hosted party at Peterson Automotive Museum celebrating the last 300ZX imported to the U.S.A. Clif is now the Membership Coordinator for the Club and also was in charge with Sheri Arnoth to coordinate the ZCSD 20th Anniversary Picnic., so as a matter to get to know him better I asked Clif a few questions, so read what he got to say:

Where are you from?

I'm a California native, born in Glendale, Ca. went to college down here in San Diego at Cal Western University out in Point Loma. Now the campus of Point Loma Nazarene. Met my wife Marcia (center photo) while there.

What is your line of work?

After 4 years in the Air Force I got out and returned to Glendale to work for the YMCA as a youth director. I didn't like the night and weekend hours, so I got a job with the phone company, and spend 30 years in the Engineering and Construction side of Pacific Bell (now AT&T, again). I retire in 2006.

How and when did you get involved with the Club?

Marcia and I had moved back to San Diego in 1981 (Alpine). Then in 1991 I joined the Z club that had just been formed. Member # 13.

What was your first Datsun/Nissan?

My dad had bought a 1973 240Z new, and when he stop driving in 1991, I bought it from him. It was blue, with a white landau top, put on by the dealer as a special package. I saw one other like it in El Cajon back in 1995. It was a 3 sped automatic, so I move on to a '78 280ZX with a 5 speed for better performance and mileage. I have also had a '91 300ZX, and the '94 300ZX convertible I drive now (see page 10).

What is your most enjoyable memory as a former ZCSD president?

The Club was a charter member of The National Z Car Association and we had a leg in the Z Across America Relay in 1995. A great group of members participated in our drive from Los Angeles to Casa Grande, AZ

What is your vision for the Club in the Future?

I'd like to see the Z clubs with the big variety of Z's we all drive, go to some of these races and support the Z effort. May's Guest Speaker Roger Daniel's Alignment & Brake





Nethercutt Museum







Our friend **Michael Libonate** has being working tirelessly putting together and coordinating once again the Nethercutt Museum tour for October 29,2011. He informed us that there are only 2 spots left for the very unique shop tour and 27 spots left for the car collection tour.

The Nethercutt Collection features rare collectibles ranging from mechanical musical instruments and antique furniture to the heart of the collection: over 250 American and European automobiles dating from 1898 to 1997.

Founder J.B. Nethercutt spent a lifetime establishing this collection of historic importance. Unique to automobile museums, each car on display is attentively service and maintained to remain as drivable as when the vehicle originally rolled off the showroom floor. On view are various Pebble Beach Concours d' Elegance winners and cars once owned by movie stars, royalty and other notable personalities. The entire collection is housed in two beautifully appointed exhibit facilities located just north of Los Angeles.

Housed in the Museum is the Nethercutt Automotive Research Library and Archives, one of the world's top automotive research facilities. Just steps outside the Museum are a resplendently restored steam locomotive and railcar. Opened in 1971, The Nethercutt Collection is an endowed, not-for-profit education institution and resource for automotive enthusiasts, historians, students and scholars. It is open to the public at no charge


