#### Power Gains

Every Z car owner eventually asks about performance modifications. Unfortunately, most performance modifications are illegal in California.

The important thing is to spend your money where it will do the most good. One modification that applies to all Z cars is a free-flowing exhaust system. Not only does this provide more power, but makes your car sound better too! Tuned header exhaust systems can be installed on the 240, 260 and 280 Z's while still maintaining legal smog standards.

## A Summer Mini Monte Carlo Road Rallye

# July 27, 1991

A Monte Carlo Rallye is a map based rallye in which each team (driver and navigator) will be given in advance their true times for each leg. The object is to choose a course that will allow the team to reach each standoff, checkpoint or course control in the correct order and direction with the lowest time error. Each team chooses their own course based on information given in the instructions and maps.

This rallye will be approximately 5 hours in length, and will take you through many beautiful and scenic areas of San Diego County. This event is designed for the novice level, and should prove to be fun and challenging for the beginning rallyist. The entire rallye is written for legal speeds and does not require any high speed driving if the rallye rules are followed correctly. Each car must have a driver and navigator (to read maps), there will be no exceptions.

Because this rallye is designed as an introduction to Monte Carlo Rallying, entries will be limited to beginners only. A beginner is anyone who has not run more than 3 major Monte Carlo Rallyes. A Novice Guide to Rallying is available for those who are interested. Please call 589-5105 for information about receiving one. There will be a novice lesson provided by an experienced rallyist prior to the start, which will explain the rules in more detail.
