Sabrina's Rules of the Road:

The Parade Magazine January 10, 1993 had a cover article about Sabrina Nickerson, a young woman who runs a towtruck in and around Tucson, AZ. Included in the article, which was interesting as the story of someone who is doing what they want to do and having fun doing it, were the following suggestions for motorists who want to save themselves some trouble and expense while traveling. Most of the suggestions relate to preventing accidents, all are common sense.

o Keep your mind and your eyes on your driving. Don't slow down to rubberneck at accidents or other distractions. Remember: your not the only driver on the road.

o Always adjust your speed to road and weather conditions, and never tailgate.

To prevent being stranded helplessly, carry basic tools like a set of screwdrivers, a crescent wrench, a tire gauge, a lug wrench and a jack. Also take a flashlight, extra fuses and spare keys. Learn basic mechanics, such as how to change a tire, a fuse or a fan belt.

O Carry drinking water and water for your vehicle [but remember never to open the radiator cap of an overheated vehicle - always wait for it to cool down.- Ed.]. Keep some snack food on hand [But nothing greasy that would make your steering wheel difficult to grip firmly.- Ed.].

o Stop every four hours for a break, even if it's only a five minute streach and walk.

o Tell someone when you're leaving home and when you intend to arrive. Plan your route before you go and take a map.

O Anyone traveling long distances - especially women - should learn self-defense or carry some form of self protection.

By heeding these rules maybe someday an ZCoSD member can buy Sabrina a cup of coffee at a truck stop in Tucson instead of making a payment on her towtruck (we'll let the Alfa and Porsche Clubs do that).




Events.
