

The next meeting will be Mar 1, 1994 at the Boll Weevil in La Mesa - see the map below.



The Z-Club has been a member of the <u>San Diego Automomotive Museum</u> Car Council for a couple of months. Here is a summary of the benefits of membership. Memberships are are \$35 (\$20 for renewal) and include other benefits such as 1) unlimited free admission, 2) 10% discount in gift shop, 3) insurance discounts and other discounts and event notification. If you want to become a member of the San Diego Automotive Museum you can save \$15 by enrolling thru the Z-Club.

What's happening with Nissan in the News?

The "Autoweek" January 10, 1994 issue reported that a new 240SX will debut in the Spring. It will have the same 2.4 Liter 4 that it has now and will be longer, higher and wider (and a little heavier). The Hatchback will be dropped, the article did not mention the fate of the convertible.

"Road & Track" in the February, 1994 issue, had a comparison test of the new Toyota Supra, Corvette and Mitsubishi 3000, along with the 300ZX twin Turbo. The ZX, now in it's fifth model year, was picked by two of the four Editors as the car they most preferred. It wasn't the fastest around Willow Springs, quickest in the Quarter mile or stickiest in the Slalom, but as the Nissan advertisement goes: "Built for the Human Race". Keep in mind that the difference in performance between these four cars can be determined by a pound or two in tire pressure. The other two Editors picked the Supra and the Corvette. My conclusion: 50% of the R & T Editors know a great car when they drive it.

Dave Platt has had the logo of the ZCSD reproduced on a window sticker. This is a great way to advertise the Z-Club and possibly attract new members. The stickers feature the Z-Car in a white outline with a yellow sun and green palm trees, they look really sharp! 


