
Treasurer's report - about \$1000 in the treasury.

January 19 - March AFB. The weather skunked us last year, so we will try again.



It must have been good for Sal 'cause he's gonna do it again this year.

The likeness of "Mr. K" beams good wishes to the Datsun faithful as our protector, "NISSAN MAN", stands guard over the "first Z".

The yellow 240ZG, now owned by Kenny Ueda, was the cornerstone display the Surfside Nissan All Datsun show 9 November Other Nissan displayed cars were the #83 GTP driven by Goeff Brabham and the #33



300ZX driven by Paul Newman.

The Datsun faithful showed up with (1) 1960's vintage truck, (1) 1600 sedan, (1) Bluebird Sedan [very nicely tricked out!!], (26) Roadsters, (25) 510's and (44) Z Cars [and that was before the "Z Kings" showed up with another half dozen]. This is a count I made at about 11:00, and a few more showed up a little later in the day - last minute primping, don't you know. About ten ZCSD members were there and/or had a car on display (including Ben with his 510 box). One of the more



popular passtimes was for folks to put their arm around the "Mr K" poster and have their picture taken . Ed Peterson was one of the ZCSD winners – he got first in the modified class with his Ferarri 250 GTO conversion (see the picture below). The number of Z's is a tremendous improvement over the turnouts of previous years. last year there were about 14, in 94 there were about 14 and 93 there were about six!! The success is due in no small part to Jonnie Renard, who sent show announcement letters to quite a few ZCSD and Group Z members.

Another Day at the Races -

On Saturday November 23 a string (2) of Z Cars wound it's way from COCO's to Palm Springs slowing only when the occasional sightseer dared to intrude on our driving space. The races were in a different place than last year, south of

the Airport and in undeveloped area. The races were more brutal than last year, there was a lot more bent sheet metal, definitely not what we went to see. You should have already read "Z: A Once and Always Legend - A historic look at what made Nissan's Z-car great" and and "Soul and Inspiration - personal car of the man who made the Z a reality". They are both great reading. The first is a capsule of the history of the Z, including sidebars describing the racing history and Albrech Goertz' conttribution to the styling of the 240. The second is a story about how Mr K's personal 240 Z has survived the years and come to the personnal car of Jonnie Benard and then to her son Kenny. Of special interest to ZCSD members is the second paragraph on page 75 where the article states that the first time the car was displayed as "Mr K's car" was the 1994 National Z Car Club Convention hosted right here in America's Finest City by America's Finest Z Car Club!! Below is a picture of the car as displayed at the Convention, from my personal archives. The sign says "DATSUN 1972 240Z >Originally driven by Y. Katayama, First President of Datsun USA >First



Automatic transmission Z in USA (Jan. 72) >Used as pace car at Ontarion Motor Speedway and displayed at numerous auto shows".



third the vendors there were last year. As we entered a young lady asked us to sign a paper that Chrysler may call and ask if we thought the race should be sponsored next year - hmmmm. The Nissan #83 GTP-ZXT went lap after lap effortlessly for 15 minutes and lapped every car. At one point the NASCAR pulled way to the left so as not to impede the Nissan's progress - it was a wonderful sight. 




