

240-280Z TuneUp Instructional Video available

Credentials: I've been restoring Z cars for 10-15 years. I rode the restoration collector car craze wave in Phoenix from '88-'90. Moved to N. Ca in late '90 and built 10 240Z convertibles that appraised for as much as \$22,000 (as well as restored a bunch of coupes). I was trained on the SU carbs whilst stationed in England '85-'88.
