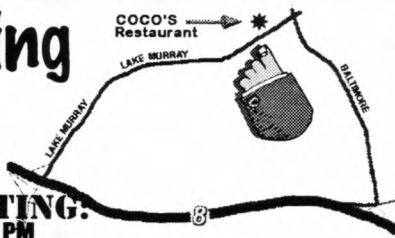
H i d e o u t

Tech Tip

Too Much Cambers Is Not A Good Thing!

(from Maryland Z Club)

"Mike, my 300ZX (1990-1996) is wearing the inside of my front tires - help!" I have heard this plea a lot lately but do not fret, there is a cure.

Camber, as defined by the Society of Automotive Engineers, is the inclination of the wheel toward the car's longitudinal plane as measured in the vehicle's transverse plane. In other words, if the top of the wheel is inclined toward the center of the car, you have negative camber. If the bottom of the wheel is inclined toward the center of the car, it is positive.

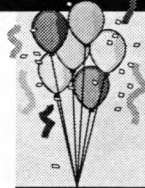
In order to achieve maximum tire life a Mk 2 300ZX should have almost neutral camber. Although specifications allow slightly more than one degree of negative camber, I have found that this much or more will cause premature tire wear.

Now for the meat of the matter; there are a minority of 300s that, after a proper alignment, persist in wearing out the inside edge of the tires. The problem is too much negative camber and 300ZXs do not have adjustable camber - what can we do?

In steps the after-market. Several years ago former Nissan factory driver Steve Millen began the manufacture of performance parts and accessories for 300ZXs. Among his many offerings is a kit (part number 308050) that replaces the nonadjustable factory upper link with an adjustable unit - viola - adjustable camber! As of this article I have installed three of these kits with excellent results. The installation takes me a little over an hour followed by an alignment followed by no more tire wear problems. Please note, this is not a cure for a car that has damaged and or worn front suspension or steering components.

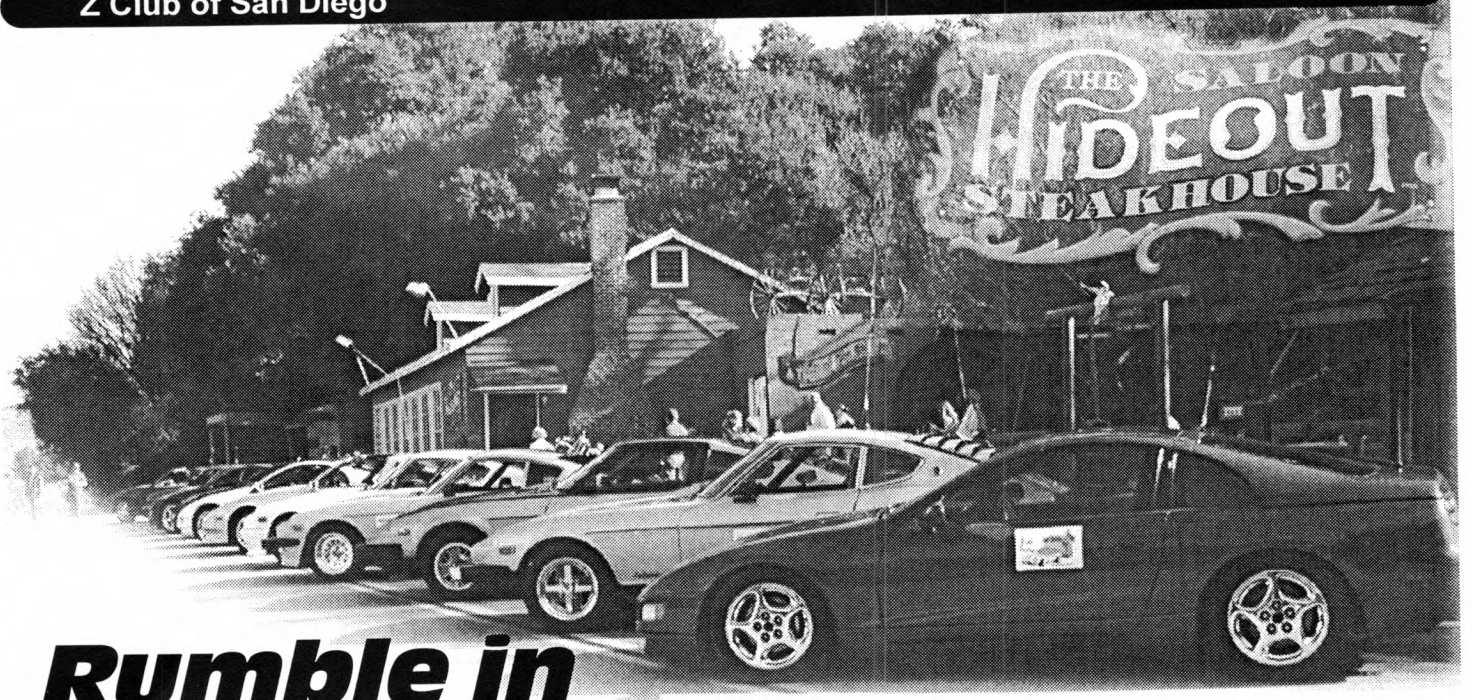

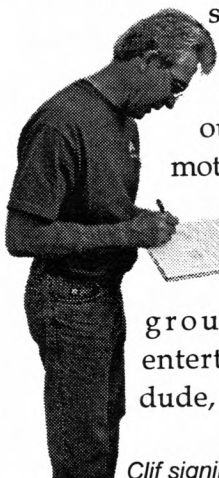
Rumble in the Mountains

INCEPTION OF Z CAR 1952



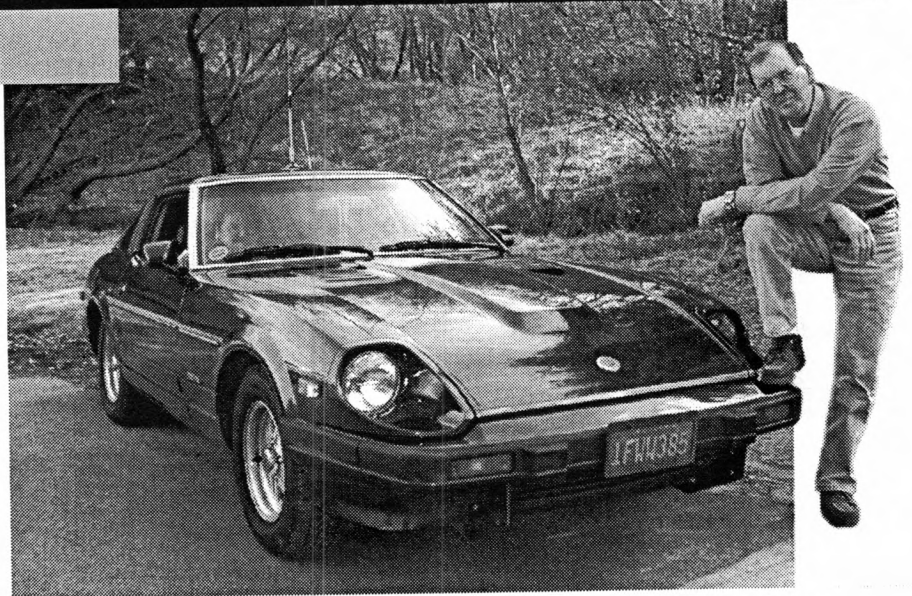
Member Profile

for rear occupants. The rear lights are shaped just like those on the first generation Z car.

Nissan engineers are working on a direct-injection version of the current VQ30DD V6 engine already in service in the Cefiro and Maxima sedans. Horsepower will be either 240hp or 270hp depending on engine configuration. Japanese sources indicate that a sophisticated version of the CVT transmission with 6 preset ratios will be available as an option to the standard 6-speed manual.

- Now We're Talkin'

Further development work on the next Z car is continuing and these are some of the modifications made to the original Z concept presented by Jerry Hirschberg of Nissan's California design studio. The new Z-car is estimated to be introduced in 2002 Fall.

Headlights are deeper-set into the flanks, and new scoops for cooling the front brakes have been added to the front airdam. This can only mean one thing: more horsepower!

Also, the rear flanks seem to have gained a bit more, probably to provide more interior space, especially
