

WINE TOUR STILL A HIT!!

International Z Car Convention and PACEXPO

Registration for this year's Convention is being handled by PLAYERS EXPRESS, 2980 West Meade Avenue, Las Vegas, NV 89102 [702-257-5055, Fax 702-365-1448, 1-800-835-6867]. You can register via the internet at their website www.playersexpress.com/zcar or by telephone (International call collect 1-702-257-5055) email zcar@playersexpress.com or fax. The events and prices per each event good until 12:00 NOON Tuesday PST 2/29/00.

Please note that the events, prices and schedule are all subject to change. Also, see the discussion below concerning Nissan's pending sponsorship.

Nissan's Sponsorship

As many members already know, Nissan has been providing \$25,000 in sponsorship funds for our Conventions to cover Mr. K and company's expenses, the Opening Reception and Closing Banquet. This year, the anticipated attendees may exceed past Conventions - there were over 700 people registered at email time. Accordingly, ZCCA has informed Nissan of this unique situation. Nissan's budgeting process is currently underway for implementation April 1 - the start of their new fiscal year.

Until ZCCA has official confirmation of Nissan's involvement and to what extent, the costs of the Opening Reception and Closing Banquet will be the responsibility of each convention registrant. When confirmation of Nissan's involvement and to what extent, is received, it will be announced by NZCC and ZCCA through all available communication channels and as required any refunds will be processed in a timely manner.

Convention Particulars

The \$99.00 discounted Convention Registration fee is good until 12:00 Noon, Tuesday, PST, February 29, 2000. Pricing on the registration form is by line item with the exception of the Exposition which is for the duration of the event.

Registration is Convention registration. The goody bag is a benefit given to registered convention attendees. The goody bag is not a purchased item. If extra goody bags are desired, than multiple registrations may be purchased. Participation in all events, with the exception of Car Show attendance and the Expo, requires Convention registration. Extra tickets may be purchased for Car Show attendance and the Expo. [Note: The goody bag currently contains: admission to all N/C Tech Seminars, one embroidered golf shirt, one t-shirt or tank top, one dash plaque, Silent Auction attendance and bidding, one Coupon Book worth between \$200-\$400 in discounts, one ticket to PACEXPO, bus rides to and from LVMS, Z Car Show spectator ticket for the convention registrant and entry in the Grand Prize Drawing for a trip to Japan for 2 all expenses paid!!].

The only other exception to Convention registration is if a spouse wants his or her spouse and/or children to attend either one or both of the Nissan 'sponsored' Opening Reception Mixer or the Closing Awards Banquet Brunch. If either Spouse is a registered convention attendee than the registered Spouse may purchase extra Opening Reception Mixer and or the Closing Awards Banquet Brunch tickets for his or her spouse and or children to attend these two events (Children not allowed in any Mixer Receptions or Epicurean Events). The names will be compared and checked off of a supplied registration list at the door.

[NOTE: if Nissan does sponsor both events, they will pay for registered convention attendees only].

Your Expo ticket gets you into the Z Car Show as a spectator. Each Expo ticket is good for one person and only that person that is registered for that ticket.

The entry fee to show a car is \$45.00 for the car. The person (s) responsible for the car must be a registered convention attendee.

Racing is priced per session per day. If you want to drag race in the morning and autocross in the afternoon, your cost for that day would be \$125 + \$125 = \$250 for two racing sessions.

If you wanted to race in two racing sessions per day for two (2) days than your cost would be \$500. The early bird price is \$125.00 per session per day. Later price is \$150.00 per session per day. Racers **must** pass tech prior to racing. Must be 16 with valid drivers license to participate in any event. No refunds.

Kids Time Out shows a cost each day of \$60. The daily charge is \$60.00. The Kids Time Out includes transportation, events (different each day), lunch and or snacks and chaperones. There is a minimum age limit.

Each Epicurean Event is \$59.00 for each event per day. The event includes all beverages and a special meal designed to complement the beverage and a speaker to discuss the tasting nuances. Usually the speaker is a master distiller.


The various Z Car Drives include park entry fee, snack, drink and or lunch.

PACEXPO ticket is good for the entire Expo. Only one ticket per person need be purchased. Registered convention attendees receive an entry to the Expo good for all week and an entry for the grand prize drawing. Pricing for the Exposition is for the duration of the event not day by day. Must sign a release to participate in any event at speedway. No food or beverage allowed on track property during the event. Must be 16 to enter speedway for expo, or just watching the events. [After 2/29/00. Events, Prices, and Schedule subject to change]



Nissan may die unless it shows more urgency--Ghosn

TOKYO, Feb 8 (Reuters) - Carmaker Nissan could cease to exist unless it shows greater urgency about changes that need to be made, tough-talking senior executive Carlos Ghosn said on Tuesday.

"Speed is a necessity, not a wish. The company is in a situation where we need to revamp it quickly because if we don't do it quickly the company may not exist anymore," chief operating officer Ghosn, brought in from partner Renault SA and known as "le Cost-Killer," told Japanese business leaders at a luncheon.

"Speed has been a little in arrears but hopefully the arrears will be shrinking day by day," he said.

His remarks follow a cut in debt ratings for Nissan Motor Co <7201.T>, Japan's third-largest automaker, by credit agency Standard & Poor's on Monday and a warning from Nissan last week that it would likely miss its target of 90 billion yen (\$826.5 million) in group operating profit for the year ending March 31.

Led by France's Renault, which took a controlling minority stake in it last year, debt-burdened Nissan embarked on a drastic restructuring in October including cutting 20,000 jobs and radically reforming its supply system.

SHARE PRICES DROP

On Monday Standard & Poor's cut Nissan's long-term debt rating to BB+ from BBB- and cut its short-term ratings to B from A-3, citing loss of market share at home and involvement in a rescue package for truck-making affiliate Nissan Diesel Motor Co <7210.T>.

Nissan will buy roughly five billion yen in convertible bonds to be issued by Nissan Diesel and lend managerial support -- moves that do not represent a large amount of money but increase its commitment to the troubled truckmaker.

Nissan's shares are down 12 percent since the profit warning and the announcement of the Nissan Diesel rescue plan, to end at 423 yen on Tuesday. They were down 19 yen or 4.3 percent from Monday.

Ghosn said he could not afford to be too sensitive to short-term negative reaction from the market and the media.

Results could not be expected immediately, he said, adding that the company was committed to achieving Nissan's goal of a group net profit in the next business year.

Most analysts say although Nissan will likely have some hiccups in the reform process, they expect it to work its way to recovery over the next three years, citing in particular boosts in profitability from reform of its supply base.

Ghosn said early responses from Nissan's suppliers had been encouraging, with over 80 percent showing commitment to its restructuring by the end of January.

Nissan aims to reduce its purchasing costs, which account for 60 percent of total costs, by 20 percent over the next three years by slashing the number of suppliers to 600 or less in 2002 from 1,145 now.

Asked when consumers would be able to buy a car that would symbolise the new Nissan, he said a new model of its famed Z-car should be on the market in 2002. (\$1=108.89 Yen)


