Casino Run 2001





Over the years, as the club's Member at Large, I have been fortunate to meet a vast variety of members in our club up front and personal. What I have learned is that we all love our Zs. However, there is always that special something about each member that makes his Z particularly tasteful or attractive—whether it is show, daily driver, or all out race—every member's Z is a treat to sit in, test, and of course "enjoy the ride!"

This month's member profile is Erik Andersen. Erik, like all Z members, puts that extra tender love and care to make his Z the absolute best. Currently, Erik works as a manager for Bookstar in La Jolla, lives in Hillcrest with his lovely girlfriend Corina. Fortunately for him, Corina enjoys Nissan Zs and has been accompanying him to many of his races at the Qualcomm Stadium (word of advice: If she's willing to go to racing events, she's a keeper Erik!). The two plan on attending many ZCSD events this summer.



Additionally, Erik has a passion for European cars. His ultimate combination to his daily driver Z would be a Lotus Elise or Espirit V8. Word has it that he has just recently acquired a 1985 Saab Turbo to his collection—another car with a potential as a sleeper. Enough on European cars, let's talk Zs!

Erik owns a 1991 Cherry Pearl Red 300ZX, which he refers to as "abnormally aspirated". The list for his abnormally aspirated Z32 can fill any Z fanatic's Christmas Wish Lists for years to come. Erik's Z32 began its trek to new found horsepower with a Jim Wolf Technology POP Charger (high flow



air filter) and a Greddy Power Extreme Exhaust System. Next came the suspension by way of Tokiko Illumina 5-way adjustable shocks and struts mated to some Eibach springs on all four corners. To further improve the Z32's already agile cornering abilities, Erik added a Stillen rear strut tower brace and Stillen adjustable sway bars complete with urethane bushings. Any other bushings that Stillen did not have, Erik opted with Nismo bushings for a complete suspension upgrade.

As time wears on, Erik's need for speed was not satisfied through the above upgrades. Erik looked further to Jim Wolf Technology for a boost of laughing gas by form of a dry NOS system. 370cc injectors from a 1994 Twin Turbo was transplanted as well as a custom ECU to handle the fuel management when 100 extra ponies are demanded. To put the power down to the ground, Erik upgraded his drive train with an aluminum flywheel and higher pressure plate. This combination allows Erik to ease in on his clutch for the perfect drag launch on stock tires without the burning and chattering associated with ceramic or kevlar units. Furthermore, the aluminum flywheel allows Erik to shift up and down the gears more smoothly while allowing the engine to rev freely to its lofty redline of 7,250 rpm.

Finally, Erik wanted to add a little spice to his Z to make it stand out. '99 OEM clear corner lights and "Z" badge were imported from Japan. Titanium pedals and a custom NOS purge button in place of his cigarette lighter were installed.

Currently, Erik has ran an 1/8 mile in 8.8 seconds at 77.4 miles per hour on street tires—a very respectable time. According to personal data acquired over the years from my experience with Z32s, I estimate Erik has over 350 flywheel ponies. Erik intends on extrapolating this number with an Unorthodox underdrive pulley, a set of HKS cams, and a Stillen Header in the near future. Further upgrades may include a '99 spec front from Japan to keep his Z looking fresh until the new ones are out in 2003. Be aware, this is one Z that will run hard and fast as its owner knows no bounds! Be on the look out this summer at our many fun events!!!




