
Member Profile, , , , Jerry Jones Owner and Operator Of J Jones Z Care


A note from your editor., Now I know that Jerry is not a member as such but he should be.

about wrenching airplanes at Brown Field wrenching Z cars for a living unless you

Coming from a family of mechanics Jerry was practically born with as wrench in his hand. Growing up in family business that was about wrenching it was probably destined that Jerry would go the same way. The difference is that the family business was in the south bay. That's a little different that consider that a Z does fly close to the ground.

After high school he started college at Southwestern, majoring in automotive technologies. In '73 he left college to start a career in the automotive field. In the summer of '74 he landed a job at Balboa Datsun in National City that would prove to be a crossroad. He worked the tune-up and service line during the day and moonlighted for the race team (BRT) at night. That contact lead to the procurement and preparation of his own racecar, a '67 Datsun 2000. A regional championship that first year ensured that the lust for speed and excellence would last for many years to come.

In 1978 Jerry went to work for a Z specialty shop at 35th and University called Personalized Z Service. He was the second of the original employees and eventually became shop foreman. The inevitable happened in 1981 and Jerry opened his own shop in his hometown of Lemon Grove. "I never wanted to be big" is Jerry's answer to why he works alone. Actually Jerry and his wife Cheryl run the shop together. The shop has waxed and waned in size over the years, with as many as 4 employees, but the desire to stay small and personal has always been a number one goal. "Scheduling can be a real problem with just me," says Jerry of the challenges facing a one-man operation. Add the fact that Jerry is a City Councilman for Lemon Grove and you understand why you see the shop lights on till ten or eleven at night.

During his career Jerry's passion for racing continued. The original 2000 had been crashed and replaced with another 2000 and was completely designed and prepared by Jerry. With an old friend and former driver for BRT at the wheel, the car was Divisional Champion in 1980 and top 2000 at the National Runoffs in Atlanta that year. The racing progressed from the 2000 to a partnership on an '85 Dodge Daytona and back to Datsuns. The Dodge was an SCCA car completely designed and fabricated by Jerry. When that got too expensive the car was sold and Jerry started racing a '72 240 Z in SCCA's stock based IT series. That car won a championship in it's first series and broke the track record four times that year. It was sold in '94 and moved to it's new home in Detroit very near it's sister car the Daytona. A 75 280Z was prepared for a run at a new Divisional series but only ran the '95 San Diego sereies, again winning the championship. Jerry says that changes in his life sidelined the racing and the car in '95 but not the experience and drive for excellence. If you own a Z or any car it should be going to J.JONES auto care......




