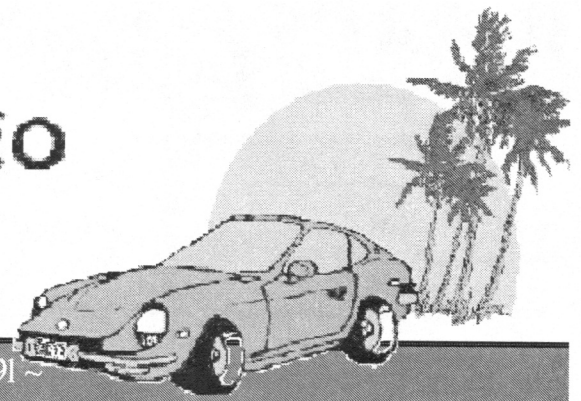

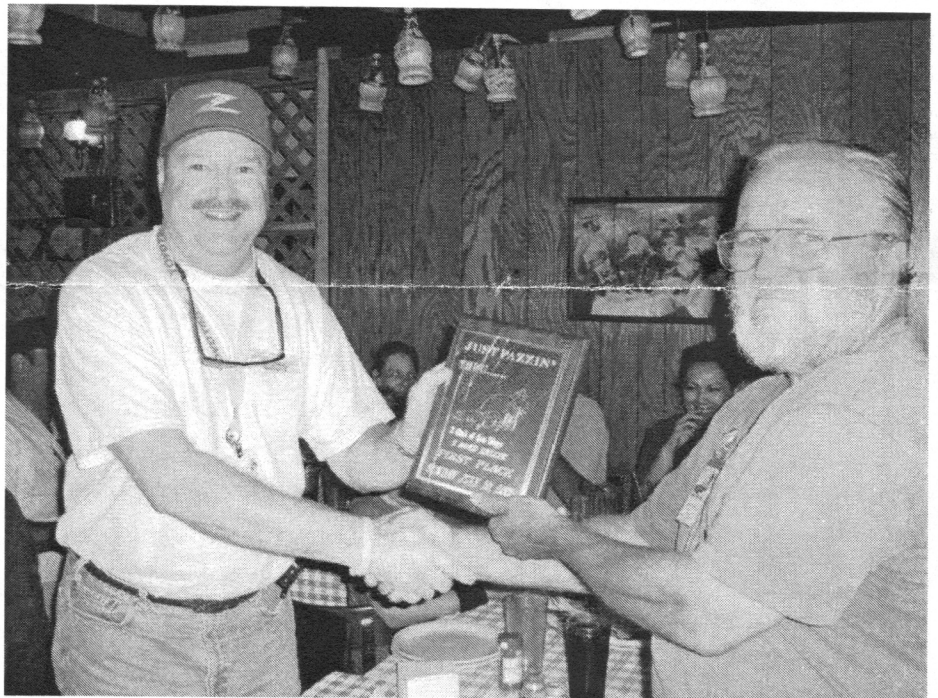
We met in the Hotel Circle area of town at 10am to start registering people. There were a total of twenty-four cars.

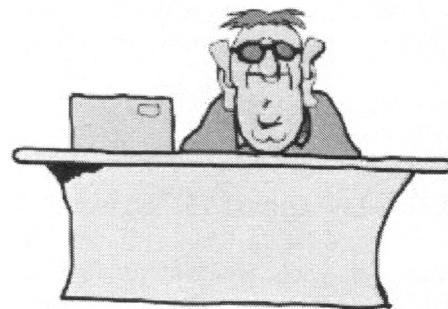

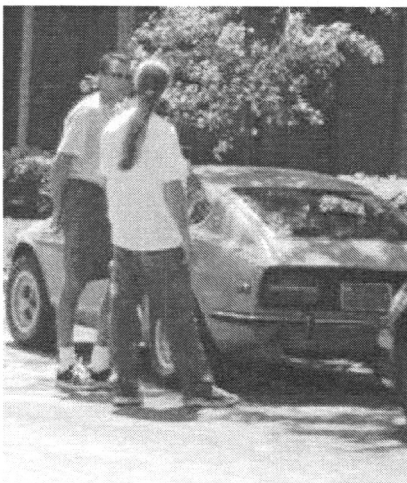

AUTOCROSSING MY Z CAR By: Les Heil, Vice President ZCSD

Were you ever curious about what you would do if your z car lost control on the street? Or did you ever want to see what you and your z can do? These are just a couple of questions we should ask ourselves.

I'm going to tell you a little about me and what it is that I'm looking for. I've owned my 77 since 1993. I never had a z car before or even thought of having one. As soon as I started driving this car, I started asking myself, "what if?" I did this, if the car did that, what it needed and so on. I came to realize that this car had potential. So now it all comes down to time and money. We either have lots of time and no money or lots of money and no time. All I know is that I want to race this car of mine and that I'm in the same class as most others with having lots of time and no money.

Now you're saying, "Just get to the point". The answer to these and many other questions is autocross. It's very inexpensive and you don't have to drive all day to get there. All you need is a safe car, a helmet (Snell 1990 or newer), a good factory seatbelt and the desire to answer these questions on your own.

If you're like me, then this is the perfect start to moving up to road racing. But if you're someone that is looking for a safe and legal way to get a little crazy then it works for you also. No matter your driving experience, auto crossing is the best way to learn how to handle these wonderful cars of ours.

Now I'll tell you what auto crossing is. It's a course laid out by cones. There's a start and finish and there's usually no more than 2 cars on course at the same time. The point is simple, get from point a to point b as fast as you can without hitting any cones. Simple? You would think so, but take it from me it's not as easy as it looks. However, it is more fun than what you would expect.

Saturdays are usually practice events. These days are good for getting in all the runs you can handle. Sundays are usually championship events which means, best time in your class wins. The downfall to this is you're normally not going to get more than 3 runs for the day.

I'm there on Saturdays so I can accumulate seat time. I've learned that sometimes when you do these bolt on installations, they sometimes cause more harm than good. I'm not talking to your car, but to your times and handling. An example would be the Toyota front brake conversion. These brakes really stop the car, but now I'm facing a terrible under steer problem. This is caused in my car by the tremendous weight transfer brought on when still using stock rear drums.

As I apply full brake into or approaching a turn, the weight of the car is moving all forward. With my front tires turned to take a turn, the car is still moving in a forward straight motion (plowing). I might be able to rectify this by changing the stock rear drums to disc and replacing my rear worn out illumines with new.

Now what has helped is changing the stock drivers' seat with a more contoured seat that accepts a four point harness. This way when I threshold brake, I'm not slipping out from underneath the lap belt or side to side. The other item I changed was all the worn out suspension bushings with the polyurethane ones. I would suggest this to anyone, no matter if you're racing or not. This makes the ride of the car more stable.

So in closing I hope I was able to articulate how much fun this is. Go to www.sdr-scca.com/solo2 for more info on requirements and registration. Maybe we can get a club event to one of these events, to show the corvettes and miatas what these cars can do.

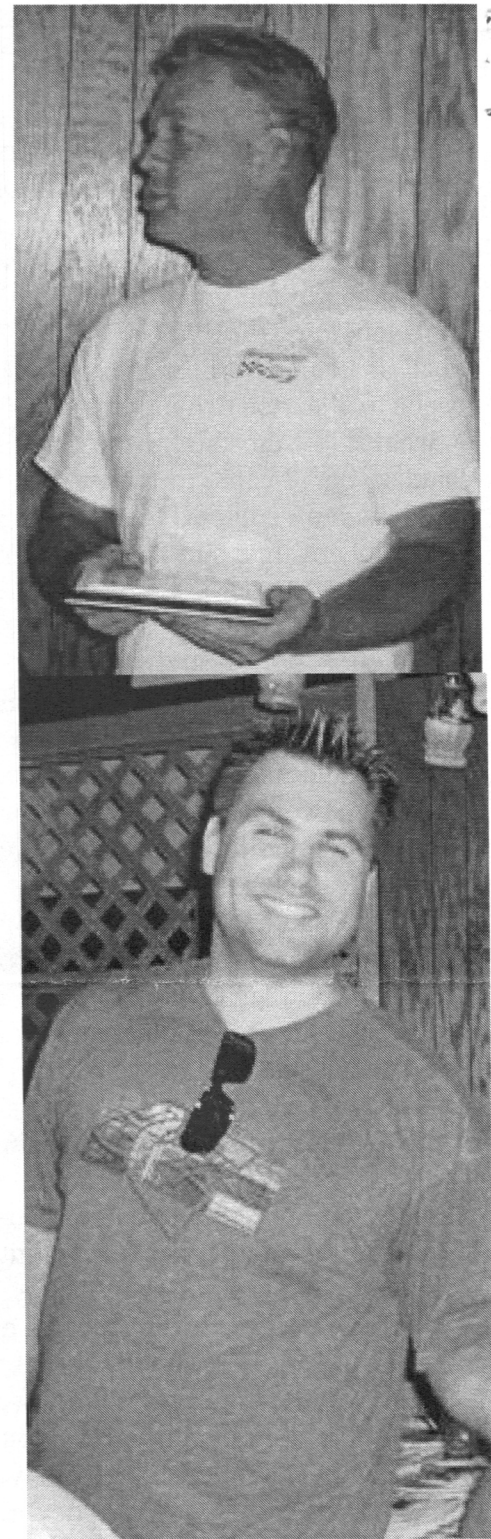
HOW TO REGISTER ON THE WEBSITE

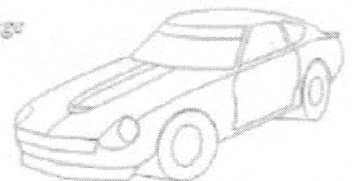

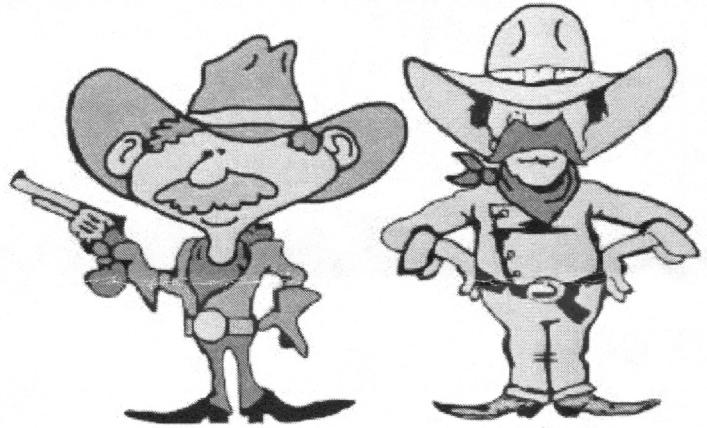

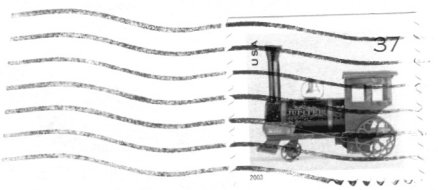
ZCSD Waiver and Release from Liability
