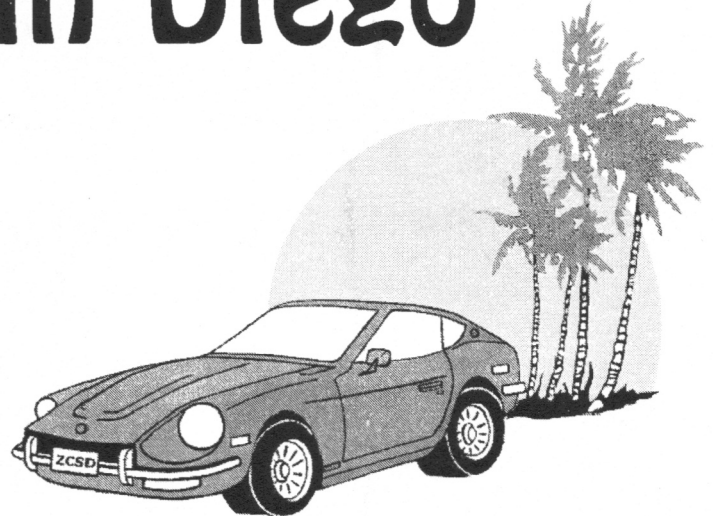

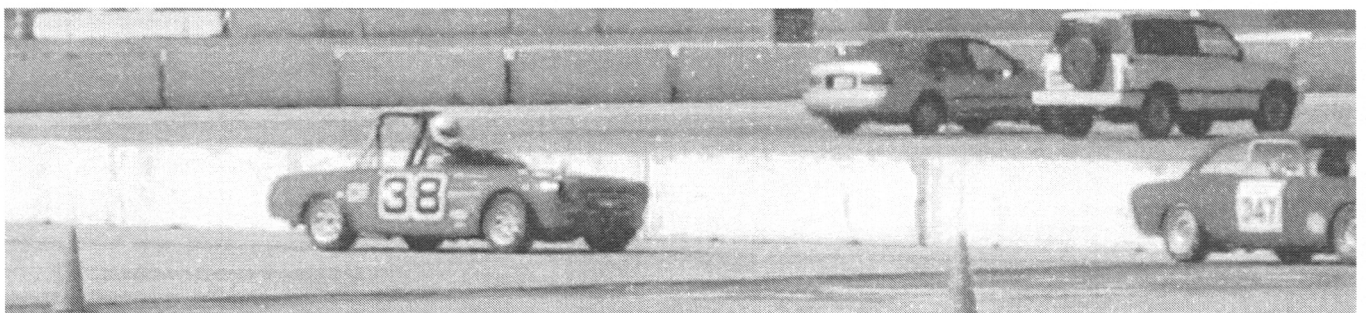

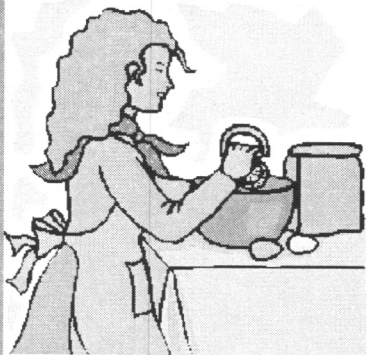
### Meeting directions:

## NOVEMBER 11 TOUR THE MIDWAY

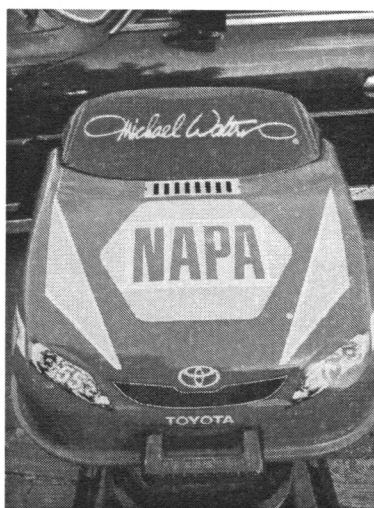
Meet at Coco's in La Mesa at 9:00 and drive over as a group.

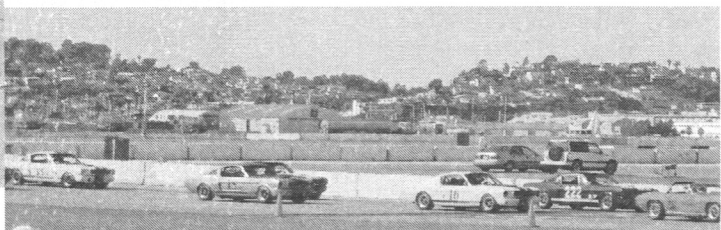
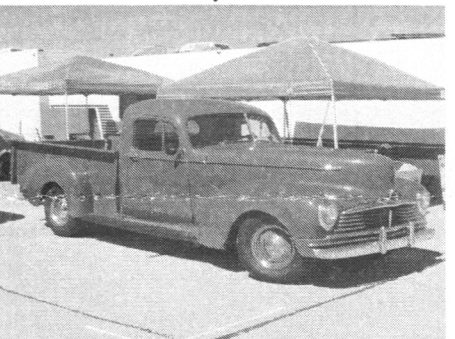
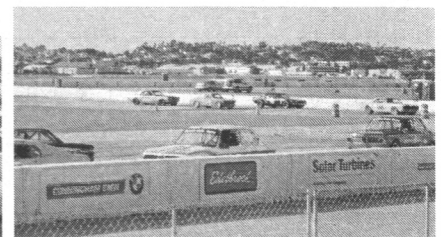

Midway tour will be 11/11/07

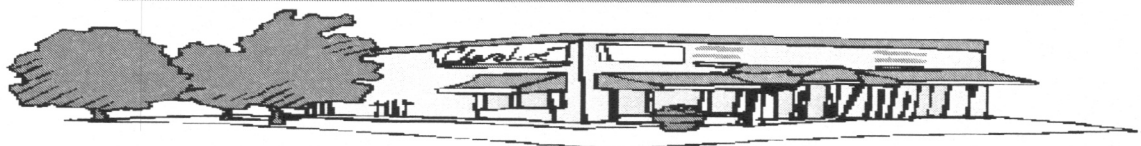
Suggestions for our Christmas Party location are welcome

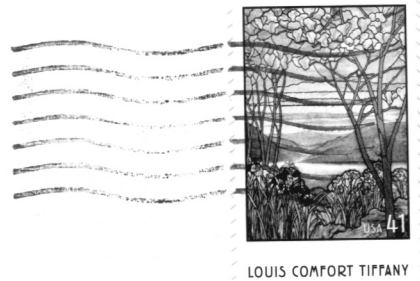
## Waiver and Release from Liability
