1/8/08 - We started the new year's first meeting with a Question of the Day. The question was: "How would you pimp your ride?" There were some great answers!

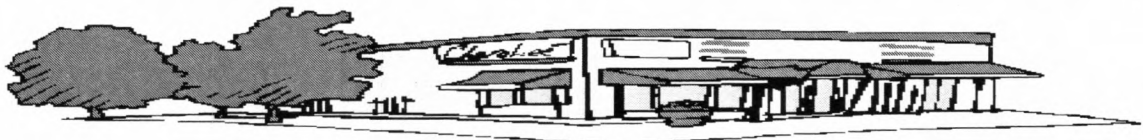
Special guest was the promoter of Auto Show USA. He invited the club to come down and show off our cars.

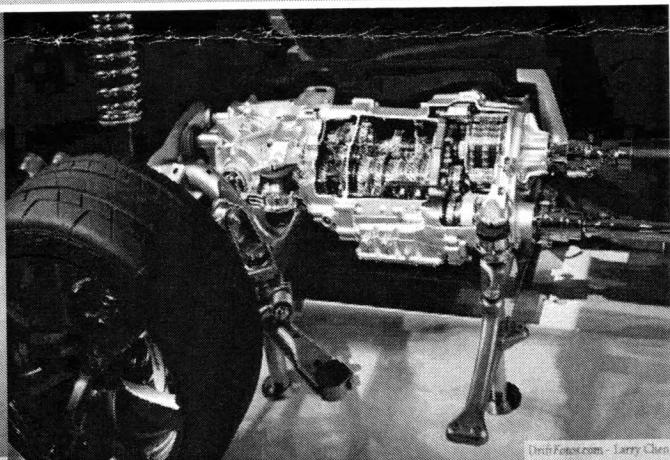
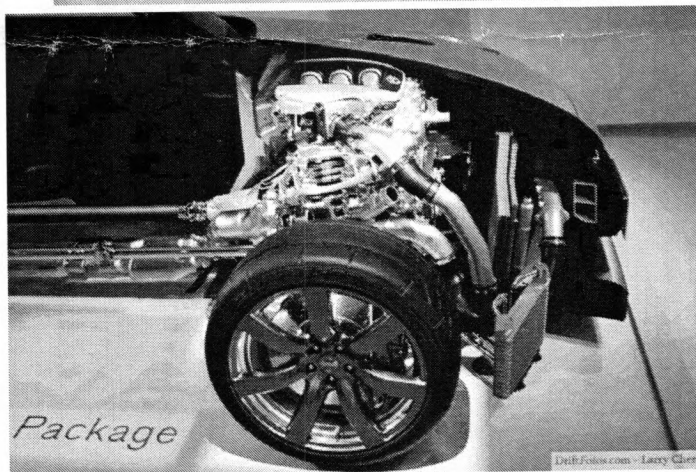
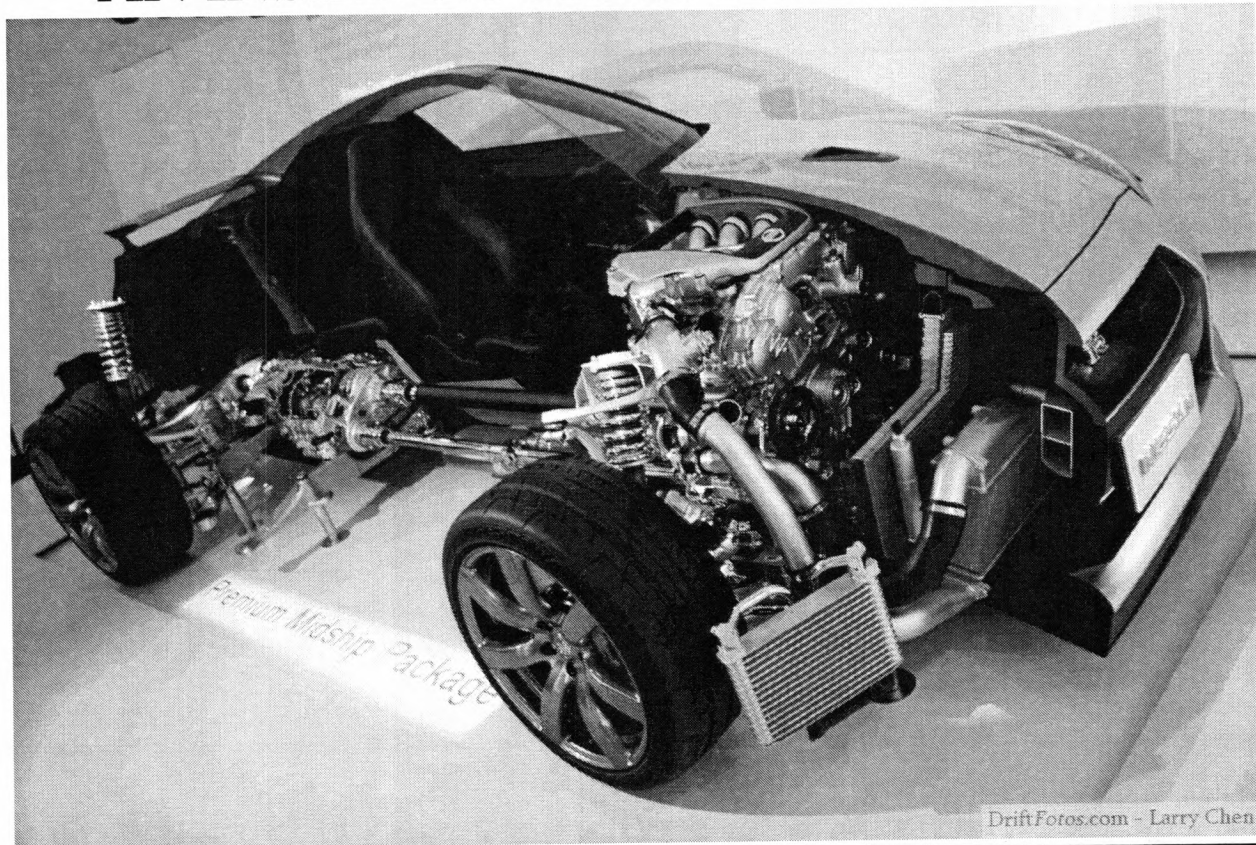
Joining or Renewing
