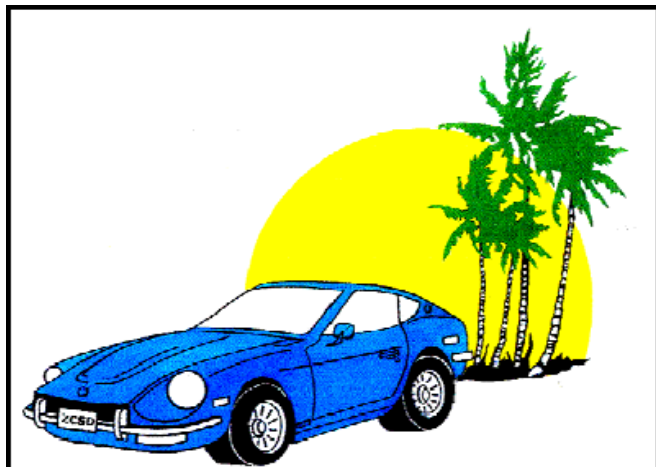

The club will pay for the appetizer trays.

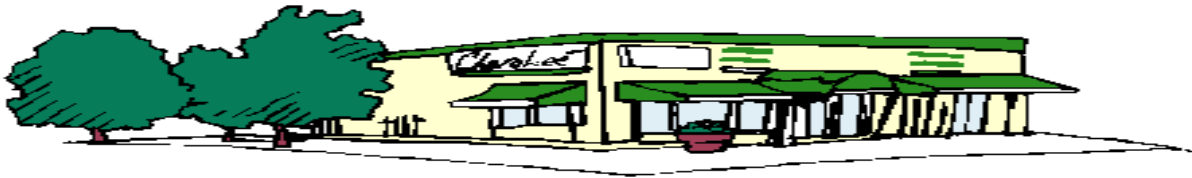
PATTY'S REPORT
