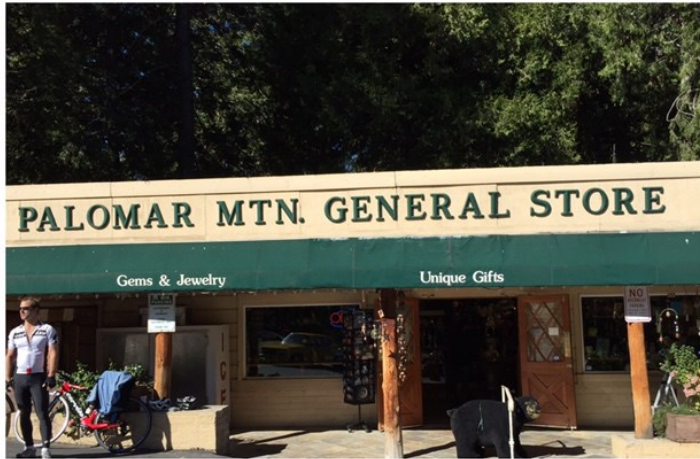


## Palomar Mountain Run with San Diego Datsun Enthusiast

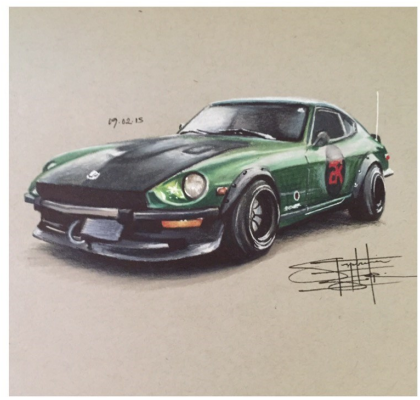








# Auto Fashion Post SEMA Car Meet

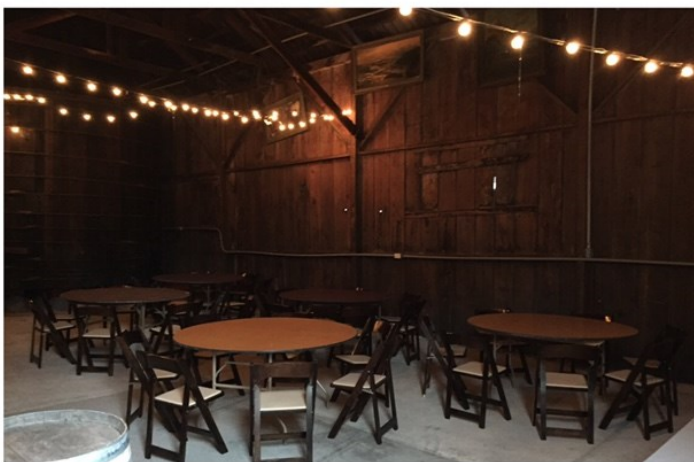

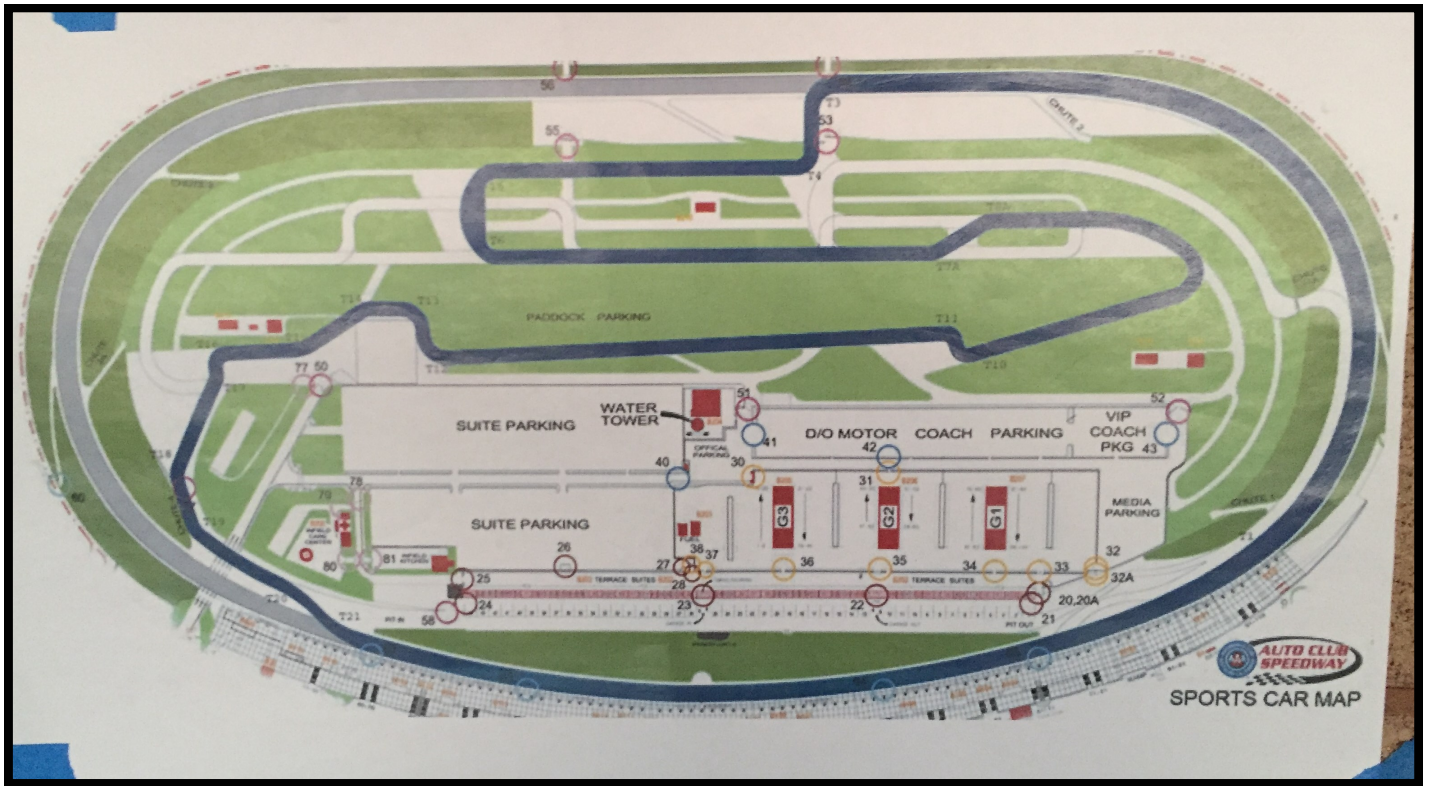

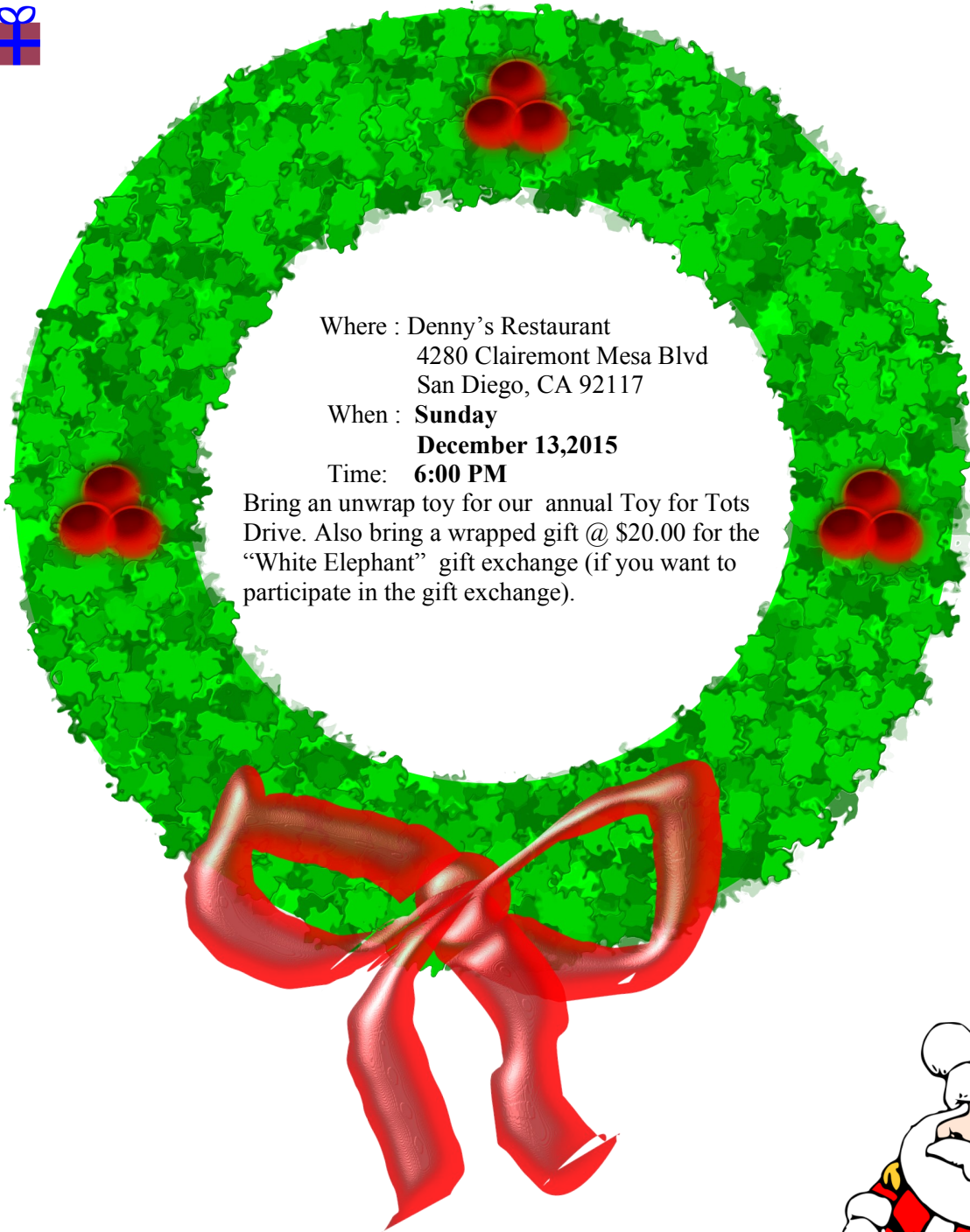
