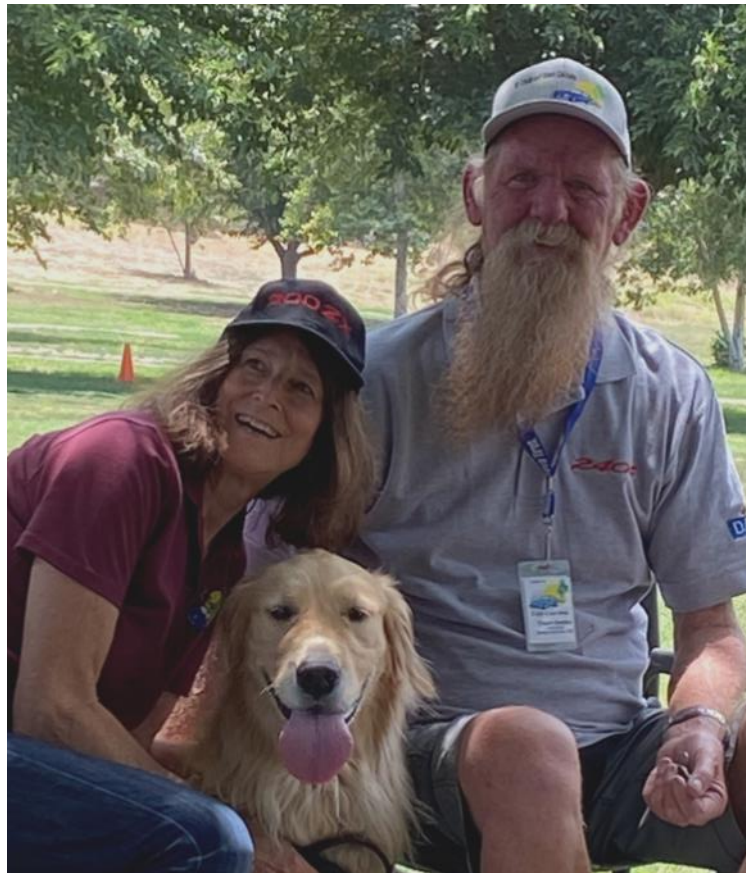

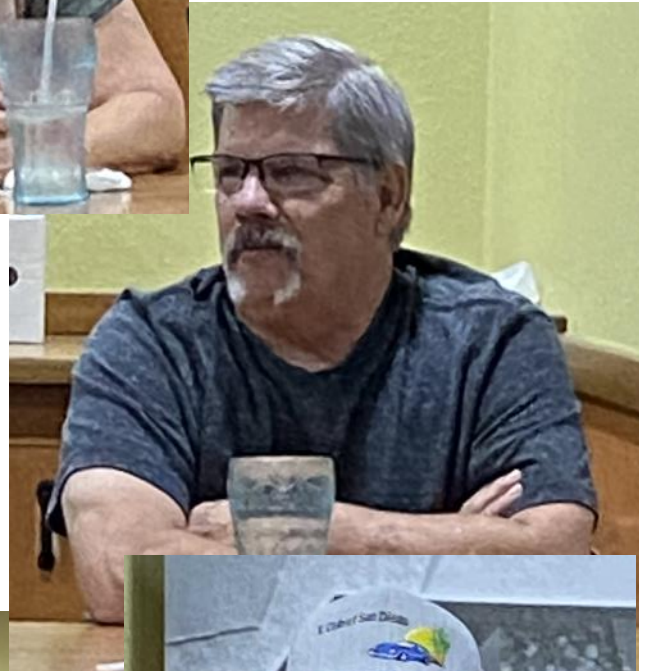

## Z STUFF 4 ZALE

DATSUN 240Z, S30  
1971

No rust, SoCal car bought new at Long Beach Datsun. Complete, clean, unmolested and very original with period slotted alloy wheels. Meticulous respray in factory color (918 orange) in 1991; reproduction upholstery and carpet (Seat) in 1992. Good glass and chrome. California blue plates. Mileage unknown, odometer shows 48,612 miles; Runs smooth, shifts well, no bad engine noises.

Transmission is JATCO 3N71B. Rear differential was replaced in 1989 but (per original owner, unverified) with an R-180 from a manual transmission car.



Included are the original owner's manual packet, warranty card and shop manuals. Many maintenance/service records and receipts. All labels, data plates and placards are in place. Original jack, spare and tools.

Deficiencies/Shortcomings: muffler is a bit loud. Apparent rear main seal leak and maybe trans filler/dipstick tube leak. R-180 differential causes speedometer error and abrupt throttle tip-in. Some cracks in dash. Engine SN does not match chassis SN. Original AM radio non-op. Rough, rich cold idle; round-top Hitachi-SU carbs need proper adjusting.

I bought this car three years ago from a friend who was the original owner. It has been garaged and driven only occasionally for about the last twenty-some years.
