From the 5;

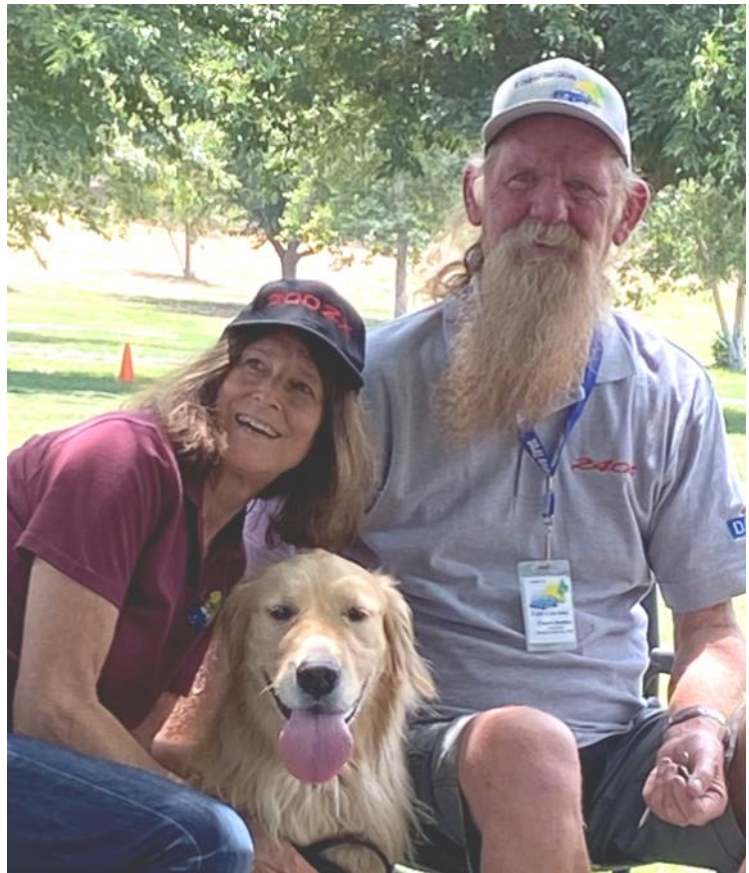
Take the 52 East, exit on Regents Road South, continue onto Clairemont Mesa Blvd, it's on the left at the end of the Claremont Town Square shopping center.

So, Gail and I went to Guadalajara Mexican restaurant in Old Town and shared Carnitas and guacamole (we had leftovers for lunch on Thursday). We also met with my brain surgeon and oncologist and my lab tests are looking good. My oncologist said that I could have a little wine or a beer with dinner. Taking it slow (one glass) after four months going without. Got some more scans ordered to verify my stability. I have my second immunotherapy infusion scheduled for next Thursday. So, I'm back on the program to knock this out.

I don't know when I will be able to drive yet, but hopefully Gail and I can attend a club event sooner than later. She would be the pilot and I would be navigator and ballast. Keep the rubber side down.
