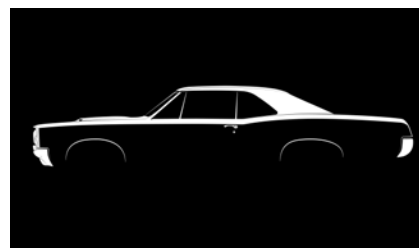

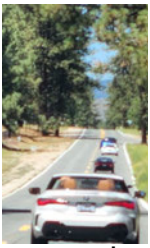
and then loaded up the vehicles and headed out towards Idyllwild. The bikes were

Treasurer – Board of Directors. Stated in Bylaws.

Membership Coordinator. This position is responsible for all membership duties such as collecting membership dues, printing and distributing club ID cards and badges, and maintaining club membership rosters.

Member at Large. Position to keep club members interested in club events and meetings by interacting as much as possible at said events and meetings. Also, represent the club at outside events such as cars & coffee and auto shows. Lead any special projects designated by the President or Vice President.

Track Coordinator. This position keeps up with SCCA and other track companies to let the club members know where they can take their cars to track events by publishing the updated schedule in the monthly newsletter. Also, this person should have the ability to try to get one track outing for the club per year. Explore possibilities with other clubs for doing events like K1 Speedway.



Newsletter Editor. This position should be wholly responsible for getting all the items in the monthly newsletter, like Board of directors' messages, meeting info, event info, articles, pictures, etc. This person should also be responsible for emailing newsletters monthly. The newsletter should go out each month no later than the week before the club monthly meeting.



Historian. This position should keep and update club histories, past members, past Z car information especially relating to San Diego Z Club.



Web Master. This position maintains and updates the ZCSD.org web page.



Club Store. This position is in charge of all club clothing and merchandise like shirts, hats, jackets, patches, posters, etc. He/she also maintains a current inventory and price list to provide to the Web Master and Newsletter for publication of available merchandise and pricing.



Event Coordinator. This position is in charge of making sure the events go well. They should be in touch every month with the chairman of the event and make sure that it gets advertised in the newsletter. They should make sure reminder emails are sent out 3-4 days before each event.

Legacy Members of the Board. These people are committee members who are invited, due to past experience and dedication, to help plan and lead the club. Their invitation comes from the current Board of Directors. They can attend any board meeting at their own discretion. Attendance is never mandatory. The post is a lifetime position, as long as they are willing to hold it. Their vote counts as any other committee member position.

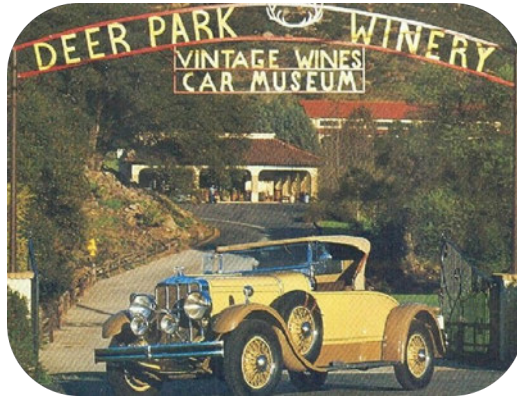

1928 Franklin Airman boat tail model 12-A convertible

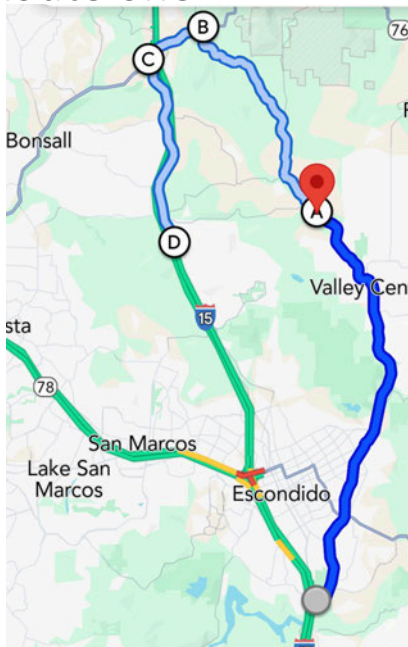

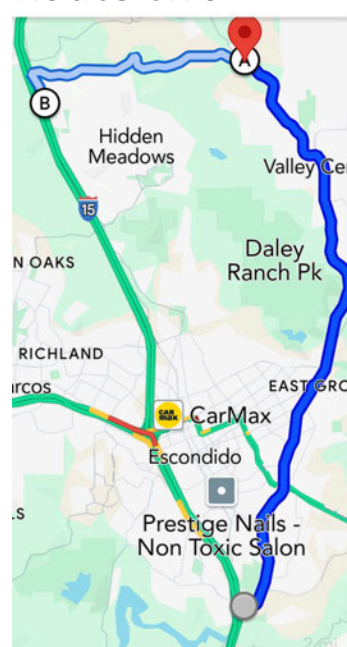
