





The use of the internet has been, and will continue to be a fantastic tool for those seeking information and getting some really great deals. However, as consumers struggle to make ends meet, sometimes quick advice or cheap prices trumps taking the time to do the proper research or seeking professional advice from qualified automotive experts. The end results cost the consumers more money, rather than providing the savings they hope to obtain.

Recently a major on-line auto parts distributor was fined by the California Air Resources Board \$233,000 for selling Catalytic converters that was not approved for installation in California. ARB investigators documented the sales of 932 illegal catalytic converters. We do not know if this company also sold any other substandard parts. Failure of substandard parts can lead to excessive emissions, which can compromise the public health and additional cost to the consumer if they are unable to meet emission standards.

ASCCA has also become aware of several on-line sites that offer automotive advice and low price parts to consumers. We've found many of these sights offer incorrect advice and convince the consumer to purchase parts from the company on-line. Then they recommend the consumer simply take their own part to any local garage for installation, enticing the consumer with how much money will be saved by buying the parts from the company. However we have heard many complaints against some of these companies, starting with selling incorrect parts and refusing to exchange the part for the correct one. Sometimes transactions can take weeks, with the consumer unable to use their vehicle. Consumers have also found they were either unable to get a local shop to install the part, due to liability, or were charge substantially higher labor rates with no warranty against failure. The end result is the consumer is either stuck with unusable parts, installing the part themselves, or recognizing no real savings due to higher labor cost. And if the part does fail, they have no real recourse, as they would when dealing with a ARD license shop selling approved quality parts.

ASCCA members and authorized repair shops are committed to providing the consumer with the best quality parts, quality service and backed by warranties that assure the consumer is getting the best value for their hard earn money. Consumers should always look for the ASCCA logo as their first step in finding a quality shop they can trust.

U.S. Auto Parts pays \$233,000 for air quality infractions

Company sold illegal catalytic converters

SACRAMENTO - The California Air Resources Board penalized U.S. Auto Parts \$233,000 for selling illegal catalytic converters for use on passenger vehicles.

ARB investigators documented the sales of 932 illegal catalytic converters by the company, which is based in Carson, California.

"Catalytic converters are integral to reducing smog-forming emissions from motor vehicles," said ARB Enforcement Chief James Ryden. "When the equipment doesn't comply with California standards, the health of the public is compromised."


Aftermarket catalytic converters for on- and off-road vehicles must be approved by ARB to be advertised, sold, offered for sale or installed in California. Faulty catalytic converters may result in vehicles failing smog checks, incurring expensive repairs for customers, and jeopardizing vehicle registration with the Department of Motor Vehicles. Enforcement of these regulations not only protects the environment and public health, but also protects against unfair business practices.

The settlement will go to the California Air Pollution Control Fund to support projects and research to improve the state's air quality.

California's air quality measures are in place to safeguard public health. Excess automobile emissions can lead to smog, which in turn can cause shortness of breath, headaches, birth defects, cancer or damage to internal organs.

ARB's mission is to promote and protect public health, welfare, and ecological resources through effective reduction of air pollutants while recognizing and considering effects on the economy. The ARB oversees all air pollution control efforts in California to attain and maintain health based air quality standards.






