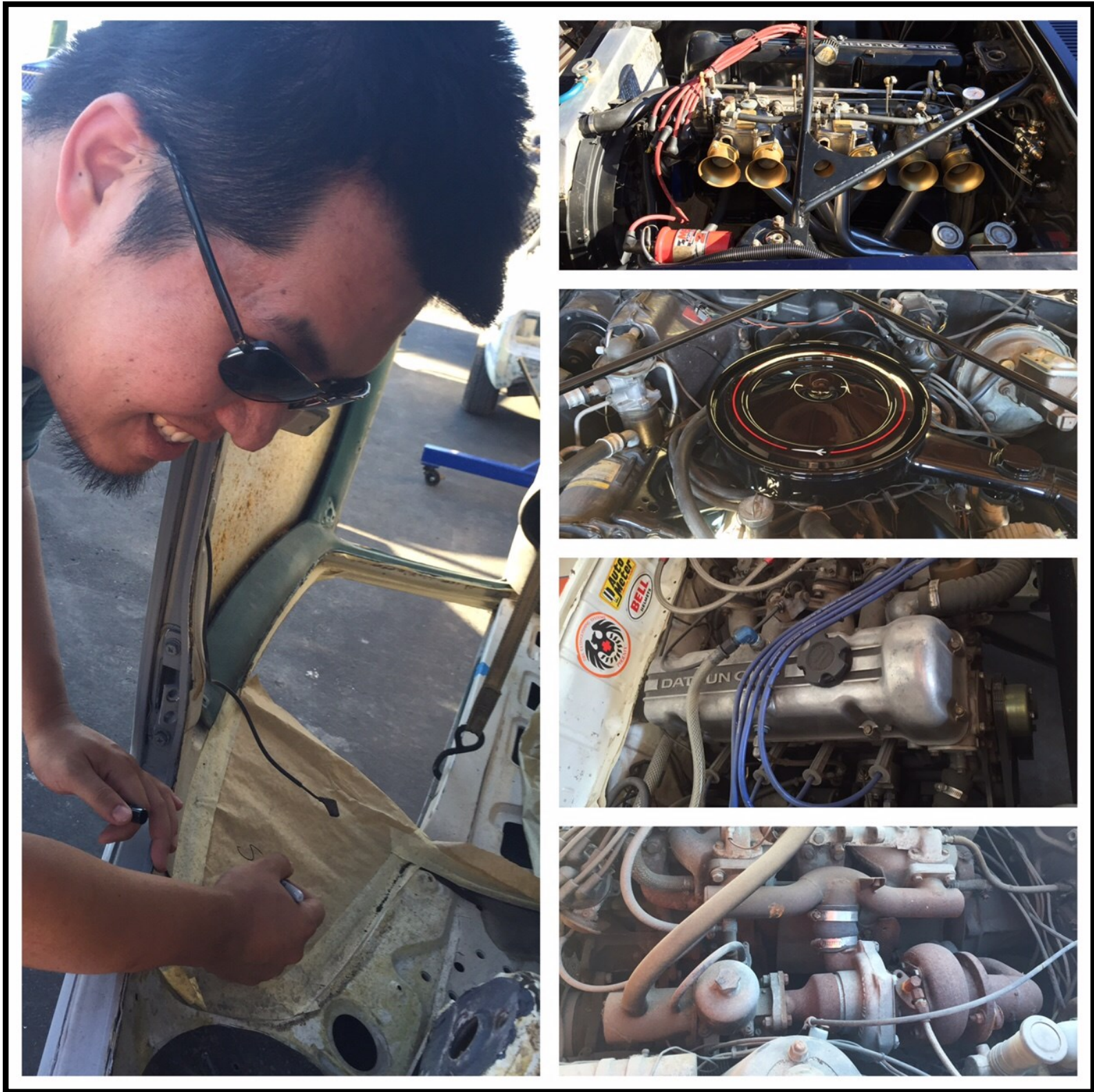


We had a very nice display of Z cars, sure they looked good at the Brewery and at the Drive in
