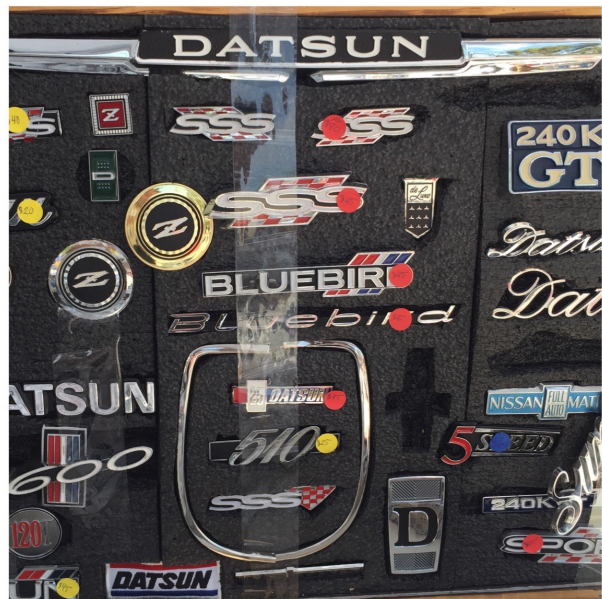

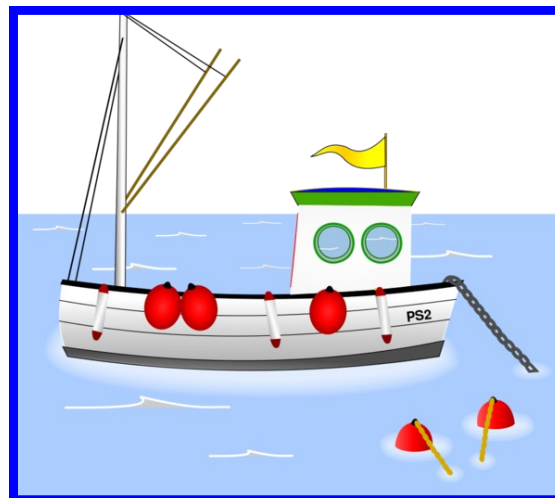

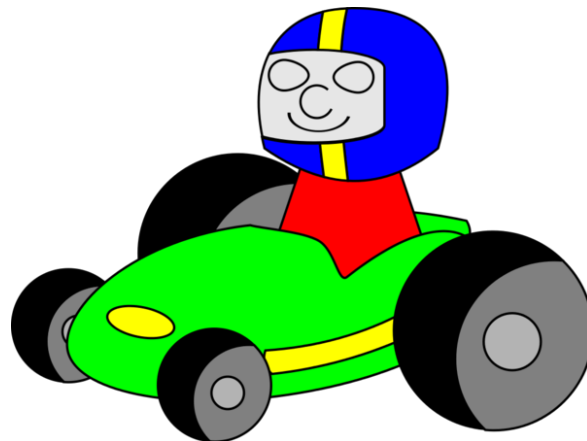

Idyllwild

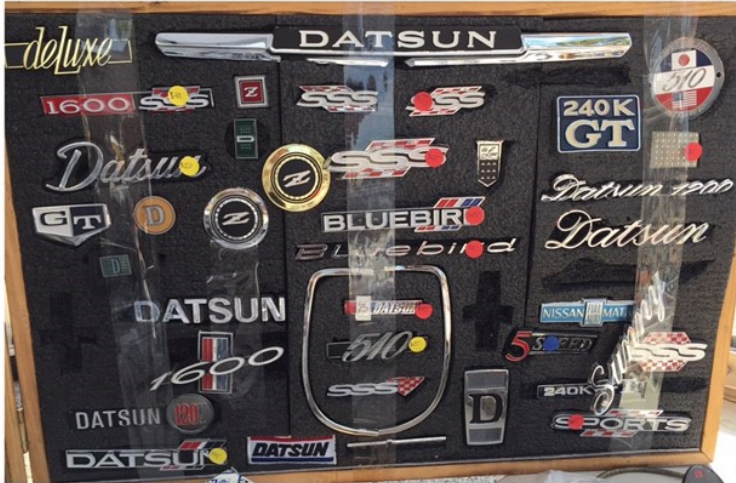
