






Club meeting and auction

Z Club drive to March Field Air Museum April 18 2026

Join the Z Club of San Diego for a back roads drive thru Valley Center, Temecula and Winchester to the March Field Air Museum. Visiting the Museum is like stepping back through more than a century of aviation history with over 115 historic aircraft on display. The collection spans over 80 restored aircraft displayed across 30 acres of indoor and outdoor space, allowing guests to encounter everything from World War I planes to modern fighter jets.

We will meet in Escondido at the chevron gas station located at 215 Via Ranch Pkwy. There ample parking behind the station on Sunset Dr. Plan on being there around 8am for an 8:30 departure.

We can take a 45-minute narrated Tram Tour of the outdoor "Flightline," where numerous aircraft are on display. These tours are \$8.00 per person and we will try to make the 11am or 12pm tour. Admission is \$18, Seniors \$12, veterans \$10.

After our visit we will stop for a late lunch before the drive home. More details at the club meeting.





Ross Lake Lavender Farm



Today started well. Today wasn't supposed to be as hot as this last week was and my wife was in my passenger seat for this event! On the I15 carpool/ fastrak I was passed by a familiar faded blue Camry. As it went by, I saw the passenger waving at us. Apparently, Hugh and Debbie were going on the run! A little further up I also passed Neal Thompson in his wonderful 240Z right before the exit on the 76.

Judy Carlson had planned this event at the beginning of the year. She sent out instructions for everyone to follow, and I was interested to see the choice of roads she picked. When we got to the gas station parking lot there were already a number of ZCSD members.



Greg Carlson's 240Z is getting some upgrades and minor restoration done to it so they planned on letting another Z driver, Rob Johnson, lead the event. Once we had our driver's meeting and everyone had some idea what was going on, we got in our cars and Rob led us along a winding route out of the parking lot to the 1st signal light to get this run started.



Once on the route, looking in front and behind we had 8 Zs total, 3, white 370Zs, one blue 350Z, a red 300ZX TT, a blue 280Z, a green 240Z, and a silver 240Z. We also had a few other cars joining in and pretty much the whole time, all 11 cars stayed together. Most of the time the Zs were close enough together to get a lot of looks from passersby and dog walkers. Going through the windy roads and looking at the green hills and the treed canopies, it really was a great drive.



With a couple of looped turns, we ended up at the Ross Lake Farm, and we parked next to the lake for pictures and birthday cake, celebrating Greg Carlson's birthday, which was the day before. Catching up with everyone was a nice break in the drive. Rob had done a great job getting us all here together!

Getting the engines started again, we were off to lunch.
