Special Announcements:

June 3 – General Meeting – Jack Saxon and Gregg Rogers, from Desert Z Association (AZ), the ZCON Chairman, and the head of Motor Sports, will join us via ZOOM as our speakers.

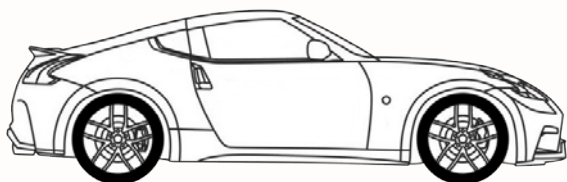

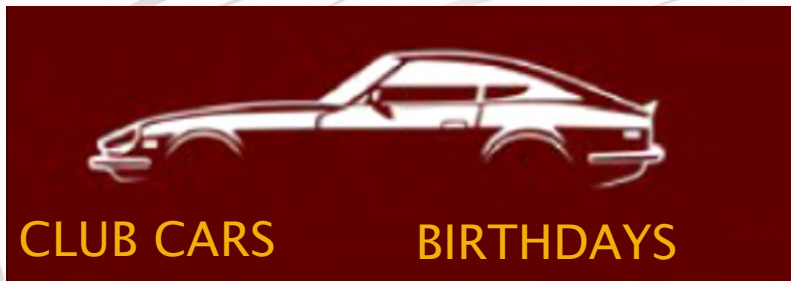

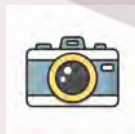
